Program/licensure requirements for this major are subject to change without notice. Any new State of Illinois mandated obligations would supersede program requirements identified in this guide.

- As part of the entrance requirements to the Teacher Education Program (TEP) a minimum GPA of 2.75 is required with at least 45 semester hours completed. All grades on the transfer transcript will count in the calculation of the 2.75 GPA to determine eligibility into the major and to enroll in upper-division courses and field experience.
- In accordance with the Illinois State Board of Education licensure rules, all candidates seeking a Professional Education License or endorsement are required by Western Illinois University to obtain a grade of "C" or better in all directed general education courses, all core courses, and all courses in the Early Childhood Education option. This rule does not supersede course prerequisite requirements in the catalog that specify a letter grade.
- Admission to Western Illinois University does not automatically constitute acceptance to the Teacher Education Program. Candidates for baccalaureate degrees who plan to complete licensure requirements for teaching must make special application for admission to the Teacher Education Program. Application and requirements for full acceptance are available in the online Teacher Education Program Handbook at wiu.edu/teacher.
- Starting fall 2020, WIU offers a non-licensure option** for students interested in pursuing Early Childhood Education as an area of study but who are not seeking licensure for teaching in public schools. Instead of student teaching in the final semester, students will have a required internship in an approved educational setting.

Minimum Semester Hours Required for the AA degree – 60 (see Note 6)

Minimum Semester Hours Required for the B.S.Ed. degree in Early Childhood Education – 122. Students must take at least 60 credits at WIU or another accredited four-year institution (30 of which must be through WIU).

NOTES:

If students transfer before the Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum or AA degree is complete, there may be additional hours in general education to total 43 semester hours at WIU. Completing the AA before transfer is advisable.

- The AA degree requires 7 semester hours of general education science by taking one course in life science and one in physical science; one of the courses must have a lab. BHC lab courses are 4 credits or greater.
 - Life Science: Any IAI L1 course. NSCI courses are not accepted toward the major.
 - Physical Science: Any IAI P course. CHEM, PHYS, PS or ASTR course recommended. NSCI courses are not accepted toward the major.

The Early Childhood Education major requires an additional 3 semester hours of science that can be taken before or after transfer.

Within the 10 total credits of science for the major, 3 credits must meet an Earth/space requirement (at BHC select an ASTR course; at WIU see advisor for course options).

- The prerequisite for MATH 210 is MATH 112 or appropriate placement score.
- Humanities: Any BHC IAI H or HF course. Fine Arts: Any BHC IAI F or HF course.
- Select one non-western studies course to meet AA graduation requirements. Course options:
Meets the AA humanities requirement: ENG 217, ENG 218, ENG 219 or HIST 222; or HUM 102 starting fall 2021.
Meets the AA fine arts requirement: ART 285, ART 286, MUSC 158
- MATH 108 meets the Mathematics general education requirement for the AA degree.
- The Early Childhood Education major has a very prescribed curriculum so students should not take random electives. If additional courses are needed to complete the 60 credit AA degree, see a BHC advisor for recommendations. *ENG 100 and/or REA 103 (taken only if required by assessment) are electives in the AA and transfer to WIU as electives.*
